## BIBLE NUMBERS OF THE GREAT PYRAMID OF GIZA

## THE QUEEN'S CHAMBER

## INTRODUCTION

The Royal Cubit ( RC ) is taken as 20.6066 Pyramid Inches ( $\mathrm{P}^{\prime \prime}$ ). All measurements are based on the meticulous survey of Professor Petrie in the 1880's. Professor Petrie took two measurements, one with steel tape and the other with steel rods to confirm all his findings. The Pyramid Inch is taken as 1.011 British Inches. ${ }^{1}$

LOCATION OF QUEEN'S CHAMBER

The Queen's chamber is the peaked room (\# 5 in the diagram). The peak of the roof of the Queen's chamber is in line with the end (\#3) of the Grand Gallery above it (\#4). The Grand Gallery is symbolic of the Age of Grace, the period during which the occupants of the Queen's chamber are 'filled-up' so to speak. The passage to the Queen's chamber begins at the beginning of the Grand Gallery, in other words at the cross of Christ. The passage (\#6) to the Queen's chamber is not full height so to travel to the Queen's chamber a person must bow (in humility and acknowledge their sins to God).

## SHAPE OF THE QUEEN'S CHAMBER

The Queen's chamber is in the shape of a peaked roof house. The length (EB) is 11 Royal Cubits; the width ( BC ) is 10 Royal Cubits; the height of the wall ( AB ) is 9 Royal Cubits; the height from the floor to the peak of the roof is 12 Royal Cubits; the diagonal of the room (DA) is 17 Royal Cubits. The peak of the Queen's chamber runs West to East.

## DIMENSIONS OF THE QUEEN'S CHAMBER:

Unlike the King's Chamber and the Antechamber, the Queen's Chamber has a peaked roof running East West. The dimensions in are therefore more complicated. The 'room' will be the floor plus the four walls. The 'peak' is the part of the chamber above the 'room'.

## INTERPRETATION OF SPIRITUAL NUMBERS OF QUEEN'S CHAMBER: ${ }^{6}$

The spiritual numbers present in the measurements of the Queen's Chamber are:
$5=$ GRACE $^{7}$
$9=$ SPIRIT $^{8}$
$10=$ LAW $^{9}$
$11=$ MYSTERY $^{10}$
$12=$ GOVERNMENT $^{11}$
$15=$ PEACE $^{12}$

The church is a MYSTERY (11) that was undisclosed to the Old Testament prophets. They searched intently and with the greatest care trying to find out the time and circumstances of the glories that would follow the sufferings of Christ (1 Peter 1:10-12). Of course, the death of Christ made possible the birth of the Church, the body of Christ on this Earth. Up until the coming of Jesus the nation of Israel was in covenant with the Lord. It might not have sat to well if the Lord told them that while they were His chosen people, He had in mind to prepare a spotless bride from the Gentiles and some of the Jews to be the focus of His love and devotion for all eternity. Now we have the full picture we can look back and see there were strong hints of the church in the shadows and types in the stories of the Old Testament. For example, Moses married a gentile. Joseph married a gentile.

Our salvation is completely of GRACE (5). Like a woman that a godly man sets his heart upon, he marries her before she provides him with any work or service or bearing of children. All that

[^2]the church has is the gift of God, we have not earned our position or our privilege from our own merits or because we obeyed the LAW (10): all that we have comes by the merits of our Savior who obeyed perfectly and was justified. When Jesus rose from the dead He accomplished a VICTORY (17) over sin and Satan. We enter into that victory. By His power working in us we experience the victory over sin and Satan too. By the cross we also enjoy the most precious thing: PEACE (15) with God. Because our relationship is eternal we expect the enjoyment of knowing God to last forever. We also receive REDEMPTION (20), a new body with which to inhabit eternity. This tent of dust we dwell in will be transformed. Now we crawl around our little neighborhood like a caterpillar on a leaf, but when we are transformed we will fly like the butterfly to new worlds. He has given us His SPIRIT (9) so that now we are saved we can bear spiritual fruit of the sort which pleases Him.

The spiritual number of PRIESTHOOD (24) marks the Queen's Chamber. Jesus is Melchizedek, the King of Salem (Peace) and our high priest. Believers in Christ are priests of the order of Melchizedek, which is higher than the order of the Levitical priesthood (Hebrews 7). As priests our duties include teaching and declaring God's praises. We are called to live holy lives in keeping with our holy occupation. The Bible says plainly we are priests (1 Peter 2:9).

The spiritual number of GOVERNMENT (12) is another dimension of the Queen's Chamber. God gave Adam dominion over the Earth (Genesis 1:26). Man was made in God's image and God is a ruler. When Adam sinned the role of ruler was lost. Worse, Adam became a slave to sin. When believers are saved part of the restoration will be to share again in God's rule.
"Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the twenty-four thrones I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes: and they had crowns of gold on their heads." (Revelation 4:4)

John the Apostle was taken by the Spirit to the throne room of God and there witnessed twenty four elders seated on thrones with crowns of gold on their heads. Here we see a royal (crowns of gold) priesthood (sitting in the presence of God). The number 24 is repeated 3 times and there are 3 references to rulership: thrones twice plus crowns of gold once. Thus it is abundantly clear we are God's priests and God's rulers, since the number of God is three.
