

BIBLE NUMBER 29 MEANING: (Our interpretation)

"HOLY ONE" (Used mightily by God: to Save His people; or to multiply His Word to them)

SOLOMON'S WISDOM: (Proverbs Chapter 30 speech on Heavenly Signs)

v.8c "Feed me with the food allotted to me."

BIBLE BOOK: JOEL

KEY VERSES: Ch. 2 v 3

"The land is like the Garden of Eden before them;
and behind them a desolate wilderness. Nothing will escape."

SIGN DESCRIPTION:

ANGEL OF THE LORD: BURNING BUSH

SIGN INTERPRETATION: (per Genesis 29)

CYGNUS looks like a Cross or a Tree, with Albireo at the base, Deneb at the top. To the right is the sign LYRA and its notable star of stars: Vega. LYRA has three smaller stars close by Vega. The Author sees Vega as the STONE which Jacob rolled away to feed the sheep of Rachel in Genesis 29. The three smaller stars are the three flocks waiting there before Rachel arrived. Prophetically the star Vega is also the birth of Moses (see our paper: LYRA). Later in his life Moses would see a marvel in a Tree: the burning bush (CYGNUS). Out of the burning bush the LORD spoke to Him. Thus, when the STONE was rolled away, when Moses was born, a stream of water poured forth which watered the sheep. Moses was the Mouth of the LORD, and from Moses' hand was penned the Law of Moses, which has been like precious water to the faithful through all generations since then. Of course, the LORD died on a Cross, and was buried in a tomb over which a heavy stone was rolled. On the third day the ANGEL OF THE LORD rolled the heavy STONE away and Jesus was raised from the Dead. When the women arrived to embalm Jesus' body, Mary M. met the resurrected Christ. But when Peter and John rushed to the scene, they met the Angel. And from the hands of Peter and John were penned Scriptures. And similar to Moses, God did miraculous signs through them. Other men, HOLY ONES, used by the LORD had encounters with the Angel of the LORD: Joshua, Gideon, parents of Samson, etc. In Genesis 29 Jacob loves Rachel but God opened the womb of Leah, rolled away the STONE, and came forth from Leah four of the most notable sons of Jacob: Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah. So CYGNUS is also a family tree, with the stars in its branches like refreshing fruit: Jesus descended from Judah. Anyone who sees the ANGEL OF THE LORD is a HOLY ONE (Or a parent of one): They are rare.

LINK OF INDIVIDUAL STARS TO BIBLE CHAPTERS:

Deneb: King of the Jews

Bible Chapter: Gen. 46

Subject: Jacob goes down to Egypt: finds Joseph is alive, ruler of all Egypt

Insight: The star **Deneb** is located in the place on the Cross where the Governor ordered a sign be posted on which was written: "KING OF THE JEWS". It was truth: Jesus was the Messiah, the rightful Head of Israel. But in the context of a crucifixion, the sign became a gesture of ridicule. Jacob was rightfully the head of his family, but suffered the gross indignity of going down to Egypt, a choice which removed him as head of the family; replaced by Joseph, the ruler of all who lived in Egypt.

Now we know the truth about the burning bush: it is a place of ignominious suffering.
Jacob was enthusiastic about finding his relatives: but years of suffering followed.
