

### BIBLE NUMBER 32 MEANING: (Our interpretation)

"TEST OF DISCIPLESHIP" (Surrender all to God)

### SOLOMON'S WISDOM: (Proverbs Chapter 30 speech on Heavenly Signs)

v.4b [Who has ascended into Heaven] "**or descended?**" [into the depths of the earth]

**BIBLE BOOK:** JONAH

**KEY VERSES:** ch. 1 v 6

"I went down to the moorings of the mountains... yet you brought my life up from the Pit."

### SIGN DESCRIPTION:

UPSIDE DOWN WARRIOR

### SIGN INTERPRETATION: (per Genesis 32)

In Genesis 32 we see a transformation. Jacob has come the border of the Land of Esau. He knows his brother is a skillful warrior and could take revenge on him if he wanted. Jacob is highly conflicted in his soul: the LORD has blessed him to "**make his descendants as the sand of the sea for multitude**"; but he is not sure he may live long enough to see it. Jacob sends all his possessions, his wives and children across the river and spends the night on the safe side of the river wrestling with an angel. Is this a Gethsemane moment for Jacob? No. It is not the end it is the beginning of his walk with God. Jesus said:

**"He who loves father and mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who does not take up his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. He who finds his life will lose it.."** (Matt. 10 v 37)

Jacob became the servant of the LORD and accepted that whatever loss followed, it was already given over to the LORD. Notice how eager Jacob is to give Esau gifts. The things that used to be Jacob's prized possessions now belong to the LORD and were to be used for winning the hearts of sinners. In the sign HERCULES we see a mighty warrior upside down. Doesn't it seem odd that the feet of HERCULES are towards God Almighty? The feet being the unclean part of the body are usually not presented to a person's face: that is insulting. God chose Jacob, unclean as he was, to be his feet on earth, to be a witness to the world. Likewise, Jacob is no longer standing on his own strength, but his feet are resting on the strength of God to keep His promises. Hanging upside down is a very uncomfortable position! Nevertheless, Jacob's humility, kind words, and generous gifts moved the heart of Esau and the brothers were reunited in a brief but joyous embrace. However, they could not walk together far because Jacob was following Jesus and Esau was a worldly man. (NB Jonah had a similar transformation: JONAH is the Bible book that matches this sign.)

### LINK OF INDIVIDUAL STARS TO BIBLE CHAPTERS:

**Kornephoros:** Thou shall have no other god before Me

Bible Chapter: Exodus 20

Subject: God spoke the Ten Commandments: People stood far off, but Moses drew near

Insight: At the foot of Mount Sinai Moses declared the Betrothal Agreement to Israel.

The first commandment is "**Thou shall have no other god before Me.**" It would seem Moses was the only one 'sold out to Jesus' because he drew near while the People stood far off and trembled; most if not all were privately idolaters. Today the Ten Commandments don't seem too strange to us. But to Israelites who had lived all their lives in Egypt, land of many gods, these Betrothal rules were radical, a whole new way of life: like Jacob they were sore afraid (Gen.32 v7).

Note: The Bible Chapter link to a star is the Degrees to True North [rounded] plus 1: The star Kornephorus (above) links to the 70th chapter of the Bible: Exodus 20.
