

BIBLE NUMBER 34 MEANING: (Our interpretation)

"MAN'S RELIGION" (communal rights in exchange for submission) [Levi's Bargain]

SOLOMON'S WISDOM: (Proverbs Chapter 30 speech on the Heavenly Signs)

v.29 [There are three things which are majestic in pace; four are stately in walk]

v.31a "A strutting rooster"

BIBLE BOOK: NAHUM

SIGN DESCRIPTION:

COCK OF THE WALK

SIGN INTERPRETATION: (per Genesis 34)

Near to CANIS MINOR "Little Dog" is CANIS MAJOR "Big Dog": it represents a nation which expands by ruthless force (e.g. ROME). CANIS MINOR is smaller and less ambitious but just as willing to use force to bully its way. In Genesis 34 we have the sons of Hamor, which are prophetic of Romans: who migrated to a distant land, built a city, and made a new life.

(NB According to myth the early Romans raided the Sabines for wives. Similar to Hamor.)

After a long period of expansion Rome became overextended. Rome had to compromise her principles and made treaties with barbarians on the frontier. Barbarians traded with Rome and barbarians fought alongside Roman troops. Eventually barbarian generals rose in the ranks and led insurrections: whole provinces were lost this way. (A kind of circumcision.)

CANIS MINOR is not Rome, it is prophetic of Nineveh, capital city of ancient Assyria. She had a strong military because hostile nations with strong militaries were near. Nineveh was infamous for brutal treatment of captives. Similar to the behavior of Simeon and Levi who attacked an unsuspecting city, put all males to the sword, and pillaged everything.

The ROOSTER is a fitting figure for this sign. The ROOSTER struts and crows. Recall the haughtiness of Sennacherib: "How will you repel one captain of the least of my servants?" Diplomacy is not a language the Rooster speaks. He can't be tamed or put on a leash.

CANIS MINOR behaves like a pack of feral dogs. This armed gang of bandits terrorizes settled people in quiet communities. But 'what goes around comes around'. Rome began lean and combative and grew into a world empire. But in the end decadent Rome [figuratively sons of Hamor], itself became a feast for dogs, [figuratively Simeon & Levi].

Subject: Moses calls for the people to donate precious items to build the Tabernacle

Insight: Was it out of piety that the People of Israel responded to Moses? He clearly said 'Whoever is of a willing heart, let him bring an offering to the LORD: gold, silver...'

The Israelites asked the Egyptians for silver and gold. Was it out of piety they surrendered all their valuables? Right after the Golden Calf incident, when Levi had rampaged through the tents of Israel killing wantonly, the Israelites weren't going to ask Moses: 'And what happens if we don't comply with the LORD's request?'
